WHOLE FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAM



Over the past two years, City Youth Now received funding from the San Francisco Department of Children, Youth, and their Families (DCYF) and collaborated with the Juvenile Probation Department to provide our Whole Family Support Program. This program was dedicated to providing direct and flexible funding to juvenile justice-involved young people and their families. In the past fiscal year alone, we approved over 250 requests for temporary and emergency assistance and addressed various unmet areas of need!
